Challenges in fecal sludge in Accra

Ocean dumping of human waste water, more than 160 trucks a day



Slamson has a solution











Sludge to dried matter into compost

- Dewatering fecal sludge with polymer
- Effluent water in lagoon and ocean
- Drying "solid fraction" (for 6 days on drying bed)
- Making compost by adding other feedstock (4 weeks)



Project description

The WASH project provides add-ons to the water treatment, by:

- Improving collection
- Composting the solid fraction of the human waste water and
- Promoting the use of this compost among Accra peri-urban farmers and citizens

All the components of project

- Collection
 - Better emptying of septic tanks (m/ce of trucks, workshops for truckers)
 - Reduced illegal dumping (GPS tracking and cameras)
 - Call center (order truck and compost, reporting illegal dumping, complain)
 - Separate urine collection (adding to compost)
 - Industrial bi-products as feed stock (wood ash, sawmill dust, rice chaff)

Composting

- 40m3 dried sludge a day from Slamson
- Covered concrete platform
- Mixing the ingredients plus micro-organisms
- Frequent turning (30 days)
- Bagging (800 bags a day) of compost fertiliser


