
 IRC, Community Water and Sanitation Agency, World Vision, Safe Water Network, WaterAid, Desert Research Institute and 13 district assemblies

Objectives

- 1. Preparation for successful project implementation
- Continued experimentation for increasing sustainability of water supply in pilot districts
- 3. Scaling up the innovative service delivery tools and models form the 3 pilot districts to at least 10 additional districts.
- 4. Improving district level coordination, harmonisation and plan investments for universal coverage.
- 5. Advocacy and training for government and NGO partners in 5 regions
- 6. Strengthening the enabling environment at national level
- 7. Disseminating of lessons learned to international audiences
