Strengthening Systems for WASH in Healthcare Facilities in Ghana (Part II)

1. Background

WaterAid Ghana in collaboration with the Conrad N Hilton Foundation (CNHF) is implementing the Sustainable Water, Sanitation and Hygiene in Healthcare Facilities (WASH in HCFs) project to strengthen WASH and health systems, accelerating the coverage of reliable access to safer water and affordable, inclusive and sustainable WASH services within HCFs in Ghana.

The project aims to:

- 1. Develop the evidence base around safe water and WASH in HCFs to inform policy and practice.
- 2. Promote and enhance civil and social accountability for WASH in HCFs

Since the project's inception several studies and activities have been undertaken to guide implementation, key being the following:

- i. Baseline and Policy Analysis
- ii. Budget Tracking and Analysis
- iii. Advocacy Strategy Development
- iv. WASH in HCFs Data Gathering and Development of WASH in HCFs models to support advocacy.

In line with the project's aim to ensure evidence generated is disseminated following validation of all findings at the district level, a national level dissemination is being organised. This Terms of Reference outlines the objectives, scope, deliverables, and timeline for a learning and sharing workshop on the National Level Learning Alliance Platform.

2. Objectives

The main objective of the workshop is to share data and evidence gathered from project implementation so far and get feedback from key stakeholders including policy makers. The opportunity will also be used to influence policy makers on the need to prioritise and budget for WASH in health care facilities. Feedback and insights from the workshop will also be useful in the development of the concept note for phase two of the project.
