- Civil society organisations need capacity to influence WASH and WRM policy.



GHANA WP OUTCOMES

- CSOs have and use evidence to influence government to prioritize WASH and IWRM integration at all levels.
- 2. Citizens are able to make clear demands to the service providers and district authority and hold them accountable for improved WASH services.
- 3. CSOs and Government strengthen coordination through dialogue, joint planning and programming for sustainable WASH and IWRM integration.
- 4. National and district governments prioritize WASH and IWRM integrated financing.
