- ♣ Mole serves as a forum for NGO's to have a voice
- For the deprived rural centers to have access to water
- ♣ It serves as a platform for discussing the challenges faced since initiation of Mole and how to provide solutions to them
- ♣ To help eradicate guinea worm from Ghana

RESPONSES TO THE THEMES (7-12) FOR THE MOLE CONFERECE'S HELD OVER THE YEARS

- ♣ Political commitment is still relevant in the promotion of sanitation. There should be enforcement of existing regulations to promote sanitation
- ♣ The concentration on hand dug wells is key to the provision of water to the deprived rural centers
- ♣ The rural water and child context should also be taken on since it influences the behavior of children
- ♣ Are the Assemblies still making provision for communal or public latrines?
- ♣ The Assemblies should set aside funds to cater for the capital cost of sanitation facilities
- Are the Assemblies in charge of contracts and procurement today?
- ♣ What has been done on issues relating to gender in water, sanitation and hygiene promotion?
- ♣ Gender issues are still relevant and should be advocated
- Social marketing approaches for sanitation is still outstanding
- Obtaining building permits with toilets is now made compulsory by the Assemblies to prevent open defecation
- ♣ The issue of taxes on hand pumps is still outstanding and needs to be tackled
- Building of latrines by communities should be a component of CLTS for the purpose of sustainability
- ♣ Issues of facilities is still relevant but issues of technology should be considered
- Facilities to promote water, sanitation and hygiene should be gender friendly
- CWSA should expand the options and remove taxes on pumps imported by NGO's
- Social Impact Assessment in the provision of water ,sanitation and hygiene facilities should be implemented
